



Members of South Australian Friends and Equines Incorporated are required at all times to:

- acknowledge that members attend SAFE events in order to have fun
- respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participant's in Club activities, regardless of their gender, ability, sexuality, cultural background, age or religion
- refuse to tolerate abusive, bullying or threatening behaviour
- co-operate with Club members and event organisers
- be objective and courteous when discussing Club matters
- refrain from gossip or general criticism of the Club or fellow members
- courteously and objectively report any complaints or issues of concern to the Club Committee
- applaud the efforts of others and congratulate event participants for their achievements
- ensure their decisions and actions contribute to a safe environment
- be aware that not everyone is confident around horses that they do not know, and keep a safe and respectful distance between their horse and other people at all times: particularly when the other's attention is focused on a lesson or other activity
- ensure their decisions and actions contribute to a harassment-free environment
- place the safety and welfare of event participants, equine and human, above all else
- ensure that equipment and facilities used for Club events are safe and fit for purpose, and immediately report any concerns to event organisers
- show appreciation for event co-ordinators and instructors
- display appropriate and responsible behaviour in all interactions
- display responsible behaviour in relation to alcohol and other drugs
- act with integrity and objectivity, and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions
- act honestly, in good faith and in the best interests of the Club, Club Members and their horses
- conduct themselves appropriately when using electronic communication
- treat all social media postings as public comment and refrain from posting any comment that is misleading, false or injurious to the reputation of another person or the Club
- clean up after themselves and their horses, removing and appropriately disposing of all fecal matter and spent feed. The SAFE Committee reserves the right to charge anyone who fails to do so a sum not exceeding \$25 every time Volunteers are required to clean up after event participants .
- ensure that stallions and colts are handled and worked at SAFE events only by persons aged 18 years and over
